The landowner of APN 006-011-022 (60.0 acres) has submitted a petition to annex into EID in order to receive water service for a future single-family residence. The parcel is located in the Gold Hill area, southwest of the intersection of Cold Springs Road and Manzanita Lane.

Recommended Action: Open the public hearing on this matter, approve CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 exemption and approve the annexation.
