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4. PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AND ADOPT THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW AND THE VISMAN ANNEXATION TO THE EL DORADO IRRIGATION DISTRICT (LAFCO PROJECT NO. 2007-05)

Consideration of Categorical Exemption #19 and the annexation of three complete parcels (APNs 085-460-16, 085-460-20 and 085-460-21) and a 0.6-acre portion of one additional parcel (APN 085-740-35) into the El Dorado Irrigation District. The total acreage consists of approximately 49.98 acres. The project site is in the Camino area. Annexation is requested in order to comply with requirements of an Out-of-Agency Service Agreement between the landowners and EID.

Recommended Action: Open public hearing on the matter and conditionally approve the annexation
